**RESOLUTION NO. 12-243**

**RESOLUTION PROHIBITING THE PASSAGE OF VEHICLES WHOSE GROSS CAPACITY IS OVER 15 TONS AT THE BAGO BRIDGE.**

**WHEREAS**, overloaded vehicles, especially those vehicles whose gross capacity is 15 tons and above are destroying the dilapidated bridge of Bago City, impacting negatively on economic growth – the damage caused grows exponentially as the load increases;

**WHEREAS**, if the problem of overloading is not controlled, this can lead to damage of the bridge which will caused burden to motoring public in the future and may endanger the lives of people and motorists using the bridge;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, upon motion of SP Member Allan C. Galunan, unanimously seconded by SP Members present, the Sangguniang Panlungsod

**RESOLVES**, as it is hereby resolved, to prohibit the passage of vehicles whose gross capacity is over 15 tons at the Bago Bridge.

**RESOLVES FURTHER**, that copy of this Resolution be furnished to the Department of Public Works and Highways-4<sup>th</sup> Engineering District of Negros Occidental, for appropriate action.
