RESOLUTION NO. 14-222

RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR TO CREATE A TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP TO STUDY AND PREPARE THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN RELATIVE TO TRAFFIC ISSUES, RELOCATION OF AFFECTED OCCUPANTS AND ALL OTHER PERTINENT ISSUES ON THE PROPOSED TRICYLE TERMINAL.

WHEREAS, City Engineer Joenil B. Lavadia, through the Honorable City Mayor Ramon D. Torres, requested this august body for the passage of a resolution approving the proposal for a Tricycle Terminal to be established in a vacant area between the Fish and Meat Market and the market stalls beside the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) Compound;

WHEREAS, this august body, through the Committee on Commerce, Trade and Industry, conducted an ocular inspection and Committee Meeting to determine the viability of the proposal, and found out that the management of traffic especially during market day and the displacement of affected occupants needs to be addressed; and

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of the august body that said issues must be properly attended to by technical personnel of the City Engineering Office, City Treasurer's Office, and the Traffic Division of the Bago City Police Station.

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of SP Member Allan C. Galunan, unanimously seconded by SP Members present, the Sanggunian

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to urge the Honorable City Mayor to create a Technical Working Group to study and prepare the Comprehensive Plan relative to traffic issues, relocation of affected occupants and all other pertinent issues on the proposed Tricycle Terminal.
